## TONY ESTANGUET: "BOUCHES-DU-RHÔNE IS A SPORTS GROUND"

Tony Estanguet, three-time Olympic medallist and President of the Organisation Committee for the 2024 Olympic and Paralympic Games, talks about the Bouches-du-Rhône department's support for the 2024 Olympics, 800 days out from the opening ceremony.





## Are you satisfied with how the Bouches-du-Rhône department has mobilised to prepare for the Olympics?

**Tony Estanguet:** Yes, I am very satisfied with the situation we are in. I feel that now, there is true collective mobilisation at all levels, including the city, metropole, department, region and national government. It is truly a collective effort with co-funding, contribution to investments and a shared desire to leave a legacy, for high-level athletes but also for regular sportspeople. There will be new facilities for the national training centre, but also for the local population with easier access to the sea, and that is important for us. We don't only host the Olympics for elite athletes, but also to create a local legacy for residents.

## Bouches-du-Rhône has implemented initiatives and investments. Are things on the right track?

**T. E:** Yes. We were able to build a meaningful project together. The legacy comes not only from new infrastructure, but also the desire to get the local population involved. And what has been implemented now by the department, by welcoming middle-school students and introducing them to sailing over the next two years, perfectly embodies the mindset in which we wish to work. We will be welcoming the entire world, and this global event must also benefit the local population. We want this 2024 generation to have increased access to sports, whether sailing or other sports. We feel like the local area has embraced the project, it's really taken off, we have 800 days to work together for the infrastructure to be delivered by the deadline, but also to develop sports programs.

## There are nearly 500,000 registered members of sports clubs in the department - do you have a message for them?

**T. E:** I think that you can be proud of what your local territory will be organising in two years. One of the reasons we are holding the Games here, in Bouches-du-Rhône, is also because it's a sports ground. There is a high level of activity among clubs, sport is important here. My aim was really to showcase areas all over France where people love sport and do a lot of sports. With 500,000 club members, it's incredible that this area can host the world's most eagerly awaited sporting event and create a beautiful celebration around sport. The idea is of course to strike the right balance between elite sport and sport for all. For me, these two elements really need to come together, to be worked on together.

## What is the general philosophy for the Olympic Games, here and in Paris?

**T. E:** Higher, faster, stronger together: that's the motto of the Olympics. We want Olympics for everyone but also Olympics that are sustainable. We decided to give ourselves a new method for working, we want to cut carbon emissions in half, and we are working on environmental excellence. That is what is being done here, especially with the work scheduled on bathing water quality. We also want to inspire people, that is important. Nowadays, in this turbulent world we live in, we need amazing moments where people come together, celebrate and share very positive collective moments.

## What was the hardest challenge? When you were an elite athlete or now?

**T. E:** Right now, I have set myself a big challenge and am ready to tackle it. I am very happy to be a part of this adventure. I loved being an elite athlete, and now, I am continuing this quote unquote dream, with the opportunity to contribute to this country's success. This country and this area have everything they need to make a success of these extraordinary Olympics and create a new organisational model.

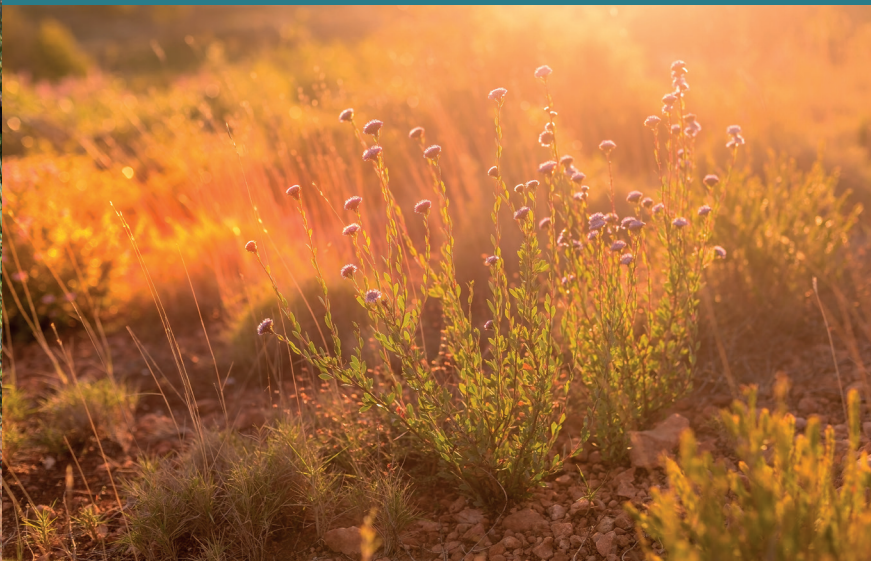

Above this little Mediterranean fishing port, 20 km from Marseille, you will see a centuries-old château and internationally-reputed vineyards.

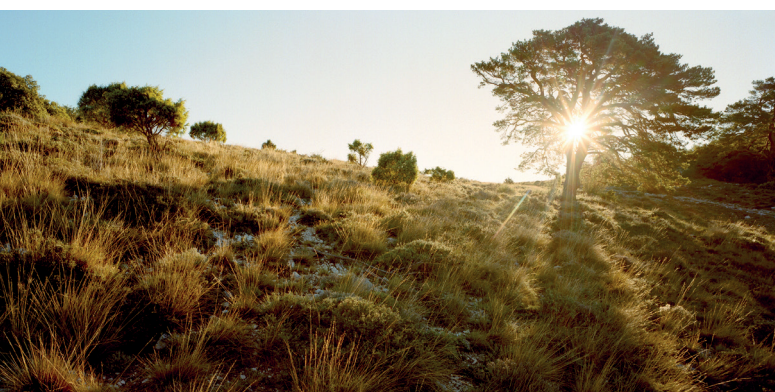
The inlets, pebbly beaches, and waterside cafes and restaurants make Cassis an unmissable destination.

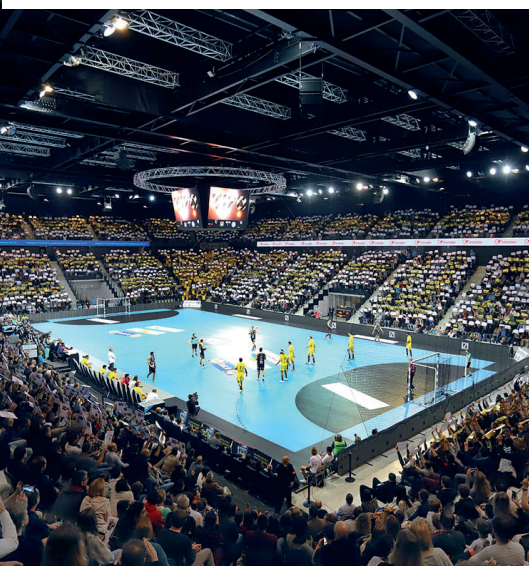

## PAYS D'AIX ARENA, A SPORTS VENUE AT THE HEART OF PROVENCE

**Ultra-modular facilities with a capacity of 7,000 spectators**, Pays d'Aix Arena has an attached gym, perfect for training. It hosts national and international sports competitions, such as matches for the Billie Jean King Cup, the French Handball Championship, and matches for the Volleyball Nations League. PAUC Handball is the Arena's resident club.

## MIRAMAS MÉTROPOLE STADIUM, THE BIGGEST COVERED STADIUM IN FRANCE

A true treasure, with surface area of 17,000 m<sup>2</sup> and capacity of 7,500 spectators, the Miramas covered sports stadium is **one of the most iconic sports facilities in the south of France**. In 2019, it hosted the French Athletics Championships.

## ROUCAS-BLANC NAUTICAL STADIUM, FUTURE OLYMPIC MARINA

The Roucas-Blanc Water Sports Centre, located at the Prado Seaside Park in Marseille, **will host the sailing events for the 2024 Olympics**. It will be redesigned and modernised for the occasion, transforming into a true Olympic sailing stadium with a marina, starting point for the boats, an Olympic village and spectator grandstand.

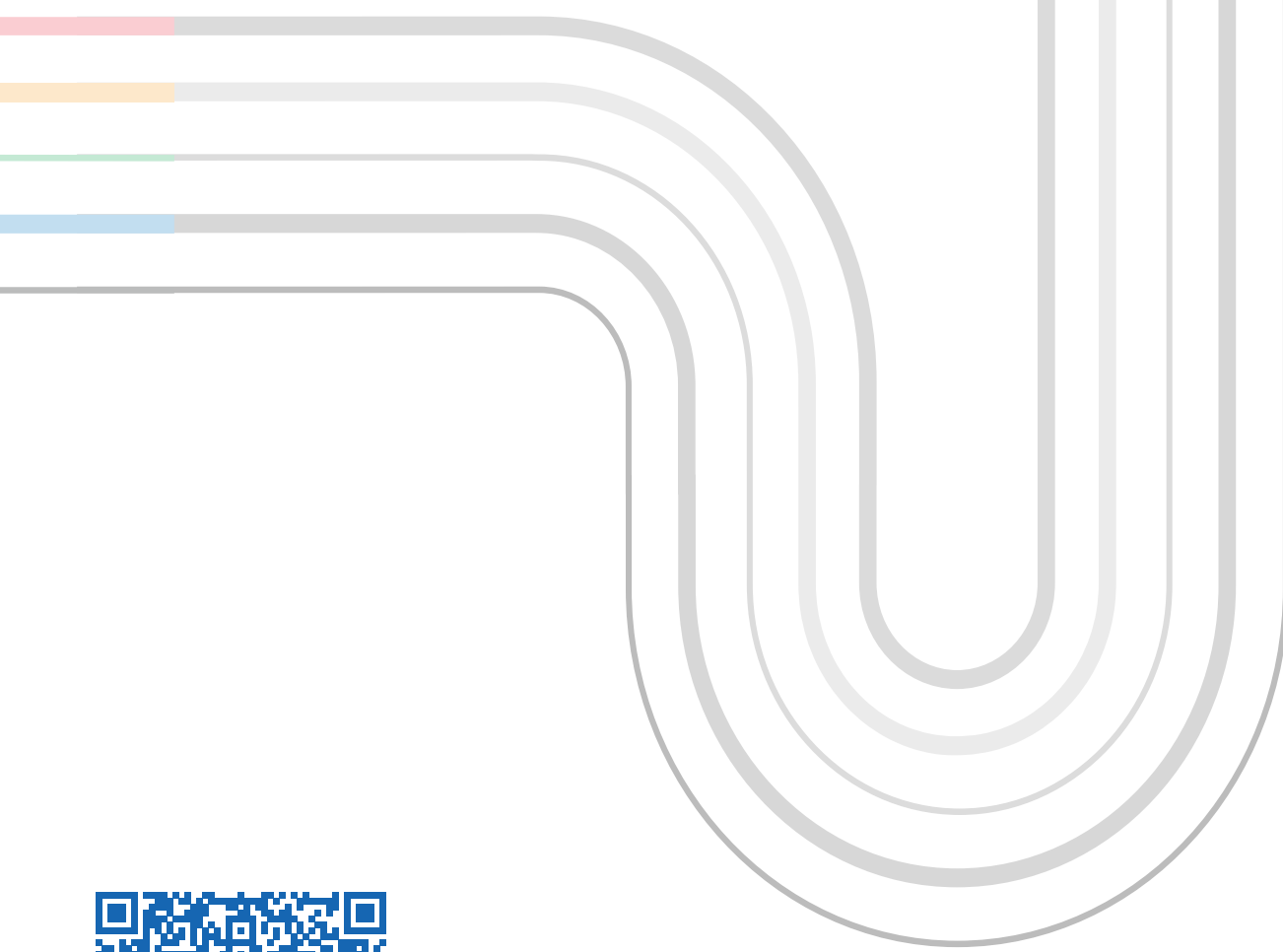
